

Travel Ban Resources

In response to Executive Order 13769
February 7, 2017

The following resources have been compiled in a collaborative effort between the Cross Cultural Centers and the International Center at Cal Poly. We are providing this resource to the campus community, noting, however, that those who were born in or are citizens of **Yemen, Syria, Iran, Iraq, Sudan, Somalia, or Libya** are specifically affected by U.S. Presidential Executive Order 13769.

The following websites and on- and off-campus resources are recommended to help answer questions for those in the Cal Poly community who were born in or are citizens of the countries listed above, and hold U.S. non-immigrant visas, are undocumented students, or are lawful permanent residents of the U.S. or U.S. citizens, as appropriate.

General recommendations at this point in time are that those from the countries affected who are currently in the United States avoid any nonessential travel outside the United States. Should travel be necessary, travelers should consult with an immigration attorney prior to departure. Individuals from the countries affected who are outside the United States should consult with an immigration attorney for advice prior to travel as well.
